

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Adults 18 to 27 yo
- Fresh Graduates that need short work experience abroad (Hospitality)
- Gap year students are ideal candidates
- Undergraduate students or graduated within 24 months
- Students must have had exposure to Hospitality, Tourism or Culinary fields (education or work experience) - see FAQ Eligibility section.
- Minimum 1 year availability (6 or 12 months placements available)
- Minimum English requirement B1



WHO WILL SUPPORT OUR STUDENTS AND PARTNERS?

- Students receive responses within
 72 hours, once they have submitted all documents required.
- Support is provided by our partners at W.I. via the Podio software.
- Partners must agree to share the email of their students, so they can log onto the W.I. Student Portal and complete all necessary steps of the placement.

WHAT ARE THE TIMELINES (VISA, GETTING A JOB....?)

- We guarantee that you will receive an internship offer in a maximum of 12 weeks.
- If by week 4 you have not received an offer, we will be in touch to detect if there are problems with your CV/Resume format, your number of applications or your interview skills.
- If by week 8 you still have not received an offer, we will give you personal training and send your CV to different companies.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO GET AN OFFER ?

- Students must apply with a minimum of 3 months (ideally 6 months) before the desired starting date (the sooner the better).
- The placement takes a maximum of 12 weeks (please refer to our FAQ for further details on timelines)
- In all cases, students must begin their Internship application 3 to 6 months prior to desired Internship start date.

VISA DOCUMENTS & PROCESS

VISA DOCUMENTS

- Proof of studies signed and sealed by the school or graduation degree
- Other documents that may be required:
- Photographs
- Medical check-up
- Reference letter
- Criminal background check
- Flight confirmation
- Invitation letter from the host company

VISA PROCESS

- After receiving your internship offer and pay the program fees:
 - Gather all Visa related requested documents; • The hotel will request the visa and the intern will be able to change their status to working
 - visa;
 - Once the student has received the Visa, the host company will start the process of the resident card
 - Once the resident card is received, it will be exchanged for the intern's passport

FAQ?

- Average working hours can be up to 48 hours per week with one day off (variable, normally during weekdays).
- Positions are customer service oriented and operational positions.
- Placement is guaranteed within the 12 weeks following the placement starting date. It is estimated a process of 16 weeks in total, 12 weeks for placement and 4 weeks for the visa process.
- Candidate must adapt to the time requested for an interview with the host
- Company and show up to all interviews requested.
- The stipend and compensations are defined by the Host Company in the internship offer.
